The children supported had been identified by a government programme as being under-nourished

The feeding programme provided a lunch on three school days each week for an average of 179 eligible children.

At the end of the financial year, the Foundation held funds amounting to £4,425.90. This was £876.5478.49 less than the funds held at the start of the year.

During the year, £3,706.73 was spent on providing the feeding programme. This was £861.03 more than in the previous year.

The Foundation's main source of income are the surpluses from organised fundraising events and donations.
